Dear Parents,

It has been a lovely week here at Ashford Hill although the weather is still a bit chilly, the children are making the most of their time outside in the lighter weather. This week the children have continued to 'sweep the sheds' around school and are taking responsibility for their classrooms and communal areas.

It has been wonderful to see the children so engaged in their learning this week and our year 6s have been working extremely hard to get ready for their SATS in a few weeks. Final preparations are being made for the residential trip to PGL later in May and there will be further information coming home from Mr Dixon.

Next week is a slightly disrupted and shorter week but busy as always, we are seeing great progress in reading from our children thanks to the Read Write Inc phonics scheme and next week we will be welcoming back their trainer who will work with our fabulous LSA team. We are currently trying to improve the home reading offer and will be looking at how to manage this more successfully in school. I am a great believer in Continued Professional Development as it is an important part of school improvement and really benefits staff subject knowledge, confidence and skills; in turn this transforms into great outcomes for our children.

Industrial Action Next Week

Once again there will be industrial action on Tuesday 2nd May. This will mean that I can only partially open the school. This is not a decision that is taken lightly, but as always, I must consider staff ratios and the safety of all of our children. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding during this time. Years R, 2, 3/4 and 6 and keyworker children will be in on Tuesday with the whole school returning on Wednesday.
