## Afterschool Care – DFE initiative and parent feedback

Thank you for completing the survey at the start of this term. After school care is a problem for many schools either due to space, capacity or demand. As a result of the questionnaire, we noted that there was not a large demand for daily after school wrap around care. Companies that provide this care ask for a minimum of 12 children daily in order for the session to be viable. Unfortunately, the most demand from our results was for 7 children on one day. This therefore makes wrap around care unviable currently. However, the Department for Education are working on an initiative to support schools to provide this care by subsidising and supporting funding over the next few years. We are currently in discussions with Hampshire County Council about potential funding for the future. This initiative is currently in the planning stages nationally, and I will update you with further details as and when I receive them.
