
What a great team!

Bag2School

A fun, free and easy way to raise funds. We all have clothing in our wardrobes that we haven't worn in ages. If you are having a sort out, please drop off your items to school in the large blue bins to the side of school. The PTA then arrange for the bins to be emptied. The driver loads the bags directly onto the van, the collection is weighed and the school receive payment! Simple as that!

What happens to the clothes?

The clothes that are collected are baled into big 'botany bales' and loaded onto trucks for export to a factory, where they are sorted into 150 different types of clothing. The clothing will then make journeys all over the world starting their new life. This can be a purpose-built second-hand shop in Eastern Europe or South America, or a market stall in East or West Africa, providing valuable employment for importers, warehouse staff, transport companies and stall holders as well as affordable clothes for local people.
